These Codes of Behaviour always apply when representing the Golden Central District Baseball Club in any capacity. These Codes of Behaviour identify a series of key principles on which players, coaches, parents, spectators, officials or administrators should base their sporting involvement on.

The Codes of Behaviour provide the basis for fair play encourage fun, friends and safe environments. This a positive document for all members and affirms a member's support for the concepts of responsibility, trust, competence, respect, safety, honesty, professionalism, equality and sportsmanship. The code also provides a reference point for all members regarding the appropriate standards of behaviour.

3.1. Requirements

The following are standards the Golden Grove Central Districts expect of all members at all times when representing the Club;

- Encourage and support opportunities for people to learn appropriate behaviours and skills;
- 2. Support opportunities for participation in all aspects of the sport;
- 3. Treat each person as an individual;
- 4. Display control and courtesy to all involved with the sport;
- 5. Respect the rights and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion;
- 6. Respect the decisions of officials, coaches and administrators in the conduct of the sport; 7. Adopt appropriate and responsible behaviour in all interactions;
- 8. Adopt responsible behaviour in relation to alcohol and other drugs;
- 9. Act with integrity and objectivity, and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions; 10. Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a safe environment;
- 11. Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a harassment free environment;
- 12. Do not tolerate harmful or abusive behaviours;
- 13. Help each person (athlete, official etc) reach their potential respect the talent, developmental stage and goals of each person and compliment and encourage with positive and supportive feedback.

3.2. Players

All players must also meet the following requirements regarding their conduct during any baseball game or training;

- 1. Compete in accordance with the rules and conditions set out by Baseball SA; 2. Verbal abuse against umpires, opposing players or fans will not be tolerated at any time during games, including off field;
- 3. Respect the time and effort put in by coaches and officials. They deserve your support and full commitment;
- 4. Understand any activity likely to result in loss or wilful damage to private property or to cause a disturbance will not be tolerated and will be adequate to constitute a dismissal from the Golden Grove Central Districts Baseball Club;
- 5. Abuse and theft of equipment, whether own or belonging to any other person or the Golden Grove Central Districts Baseball Club, will not be tolerated.

3.3. Coaches

All coaches must also meet the following requirements regarding their conduct during any baseball game or training;

- 1. Operate within the rules and spirit of the game, promoting fair play over winning at any cost;
- 2. Never ridicule or yell at a young player for making a mistake or not coming first;
- 3. Be reasonable in your demands on players' time, energy and enthusiasm;
- 4. Ensure that the time players spend with you is a positive experience. All young people are deserving of equal attention and opportunities;
- 5. Any physical contact with a young person should be appropriate to the situation and necessary for the player's skill development;

3.4. Parents and Spectators

All parents and supporters must also meet the following requirements regarding their conduct during any baseball activity or event;

- 1. Remember young players participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours;
- 2. Never ridicule or scald a young player for making a mistake;
- 3. Show respect for your team's opponents;
- 4. Not interfere with the play of the game in any manner. This includes running onto the field or throwing objects onto the field of play;
- 5. Ensure you are aware and follow the correct processes if you have an issue or grievance; do not perpetuate issues with gossip or general criticism.

3.5. Officials

All officials must also meet the following requirements regarding their conduct during any baseball game or training;

- 1. Be consistent, objective and courteous when making decisions;
- 2. Condemn unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all opponents; 3.

Emphasise the spirit of the game rather than the errors;

4. Encourage and promote rule changes, which will make participation more enjoyable; 5.

Be a good sport yourself. Actions speak louder than words;

- 6. Remember, you set an example. Your behaviour and comments should be positive and supportive;
- 7. Place the safety and welfare of the participants above all else.

3.6. Administrators

All administrators must also meet the following requirements regarding their conduct;

- 1. Involve young people in planning, leadership, evaluation and decision making related to the activity;
- 2. Give all young people equal opportunities to participate;

- 3. Provide quality supervision and instruction for junior players;
- 4. Help coaches and officials highlight appropriate behaviour and skill development, and help improve the standards of coaching and officiating;
- 5. Remember, you set an example. Your behaviour and comments should be positive and supportive;
- 6. Make it clear that abusing anybody in any way is unacceptable and will result in disciplinary action.

By becoming a part of the Golden Grove Central Districts community; as a member, you have the opportunity to represent a club with a reputable and rich history. The Golden Grove Central Districts Baseball Club community will be held accountable to a high level of professional conduct in areas both on and off the field while representing the Golden Grove Central Districts Baseball Club or your team.

In the event of inappropriate behaviour or acting in a manner, that breaches this Codes of Behaviour and/or bringing the team and game into disrepute, the individual should be reported as soon as practical. This can be achieved by speaking to any member of the Central Districts Baseball Club Board.

Members have a responsibility to report such incidents to the Golden Grove Central Districts Baseball Club Board or the correct authority and the Board can exercise its rights to take appropriate action.

In the case where an issue arises between a parent/guardian and the coach, parents should refer to the GGCD Grievance Policy.

5. Penalties

Anyone breaching the Code of Behaviours may be ejected from the game and the boundaries of the Club immediately and/or for an appropriate length of time. Severe infractions or repeat offences can result in the loss of, membership, membership privileges and/or the right to attend any trainings, games or social events held at the Golden Grove Central Districts Baseball Club.

Breaches relating to on field infractions may result in penalties, including but not limited to:

- (a) Suspension of a match and/or
 - b) Termination of a match (including potential forfeiture of competition points) and/or c) Suspension of a player on a temporary or permanent basis and/or
 - d) Loss of Membership Privileges and/or
 - e) Membership

These penalties are in addition to any penalty which may be imposed by Baseball SA. Any additional expense incurred will be the responsibility of the athlete or their parent/guardian.
